Suggestion

- We set a 3 year term for chairs, after which they're automatically unappointed but can be reappointed by the working group
- We do this in a staggered way to ensure continuity
- Selecting a chair happens on the mailing list
- We aim to always have 2 co-chairs

RIPE72

THE PROCESS

(SHAMELESSLY STOLEN FROM COOPERATION-WG)

The process for selecting a new chair is as follows:

- A call for interested parties is made on the WG mailing list at least every three years, or whenever needed.
- Interested parties have two weeks to make their interest known via the mailing list, or directly to the Chair/s.
- After two weeks, the Chair/s ensure that all candidates are announced on the mailing list and issue a call
 for discussion.
- 4. WG members express their approval or otherwise of the presented candidates.
- Two weeks after the call for discussion, the Chair/s declare a decision, based on mailing list discussion, as they would do for a policy proposal.

It's been 3 years.

- Based on the agreed process from RIPE72 we'll do a call for interested parties on the mailing list this week
- We'll announce the full list of candidates after 2 weeks and open the discussion
- Two weeks later, the chairs declare a decision based on feedback on the mailing list.
- No feedback means Florence and I get to decide whatever we want :-)

Timeline

- October 25 Call for nominations
- November 8 Announcing the list of candidates
- November 8-21 Discussion phase
- November 22 Decision by current WG chairs
