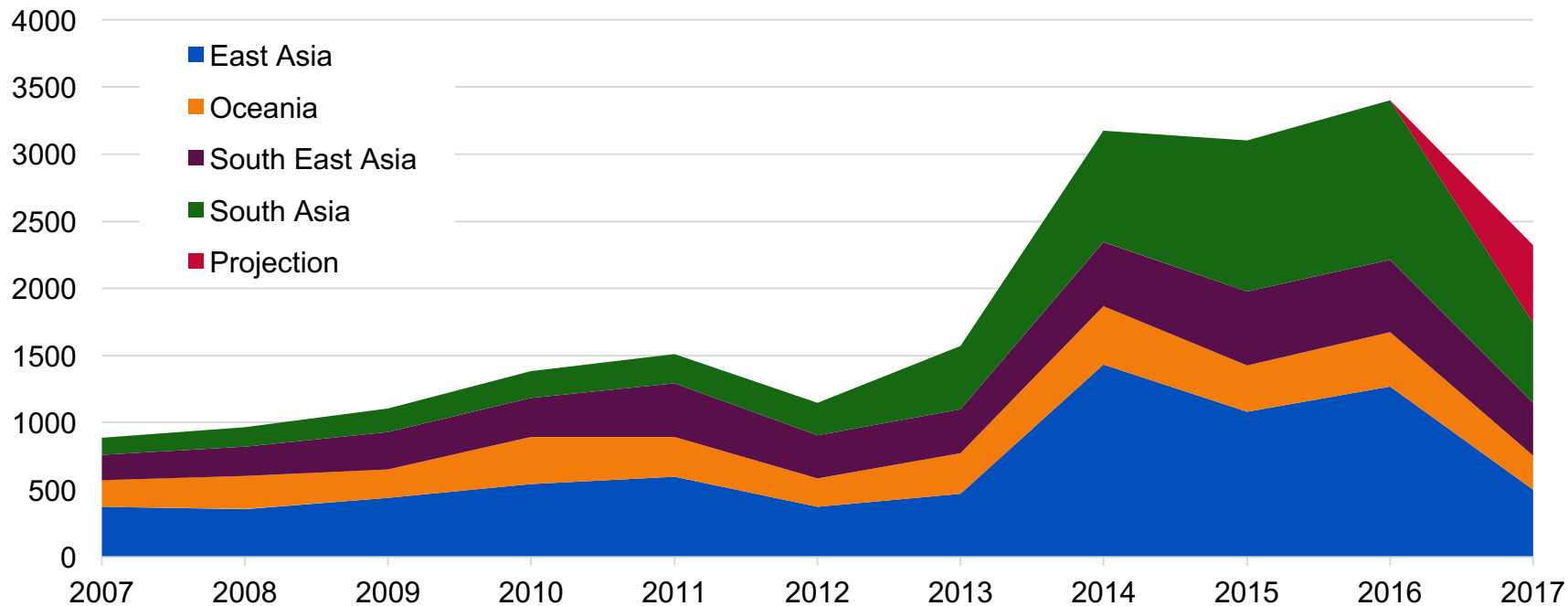

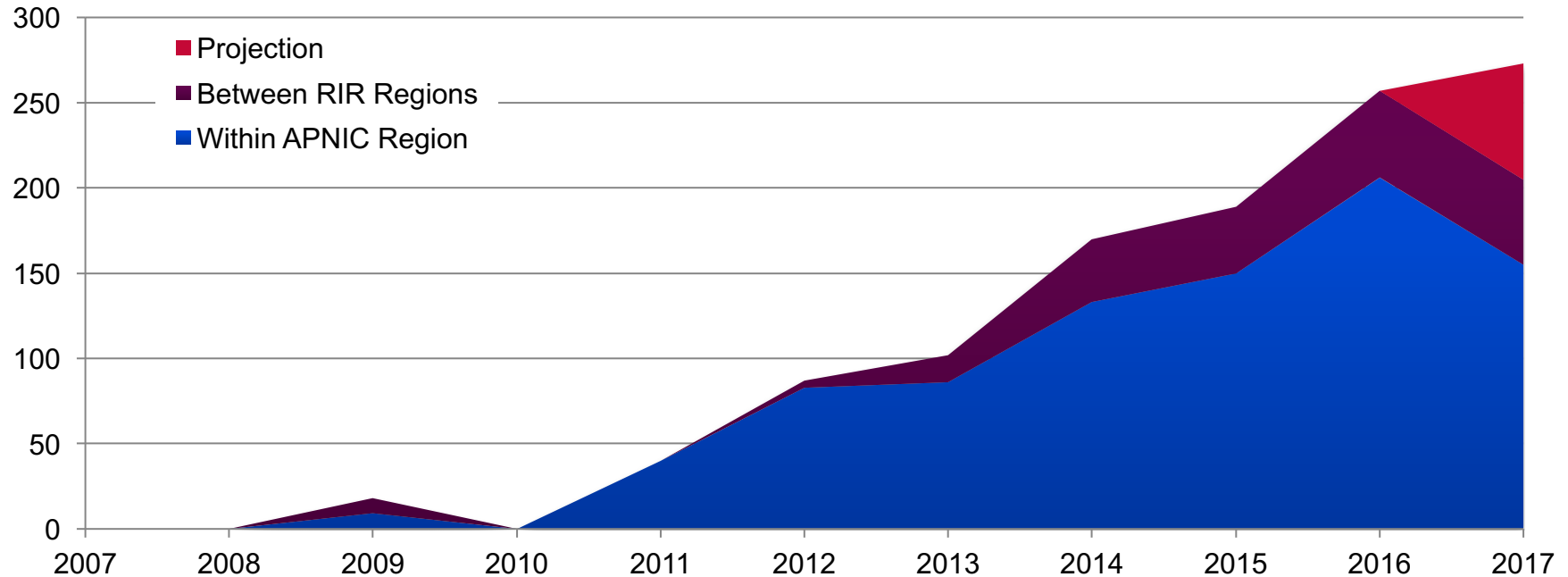
IPv4 Delegations

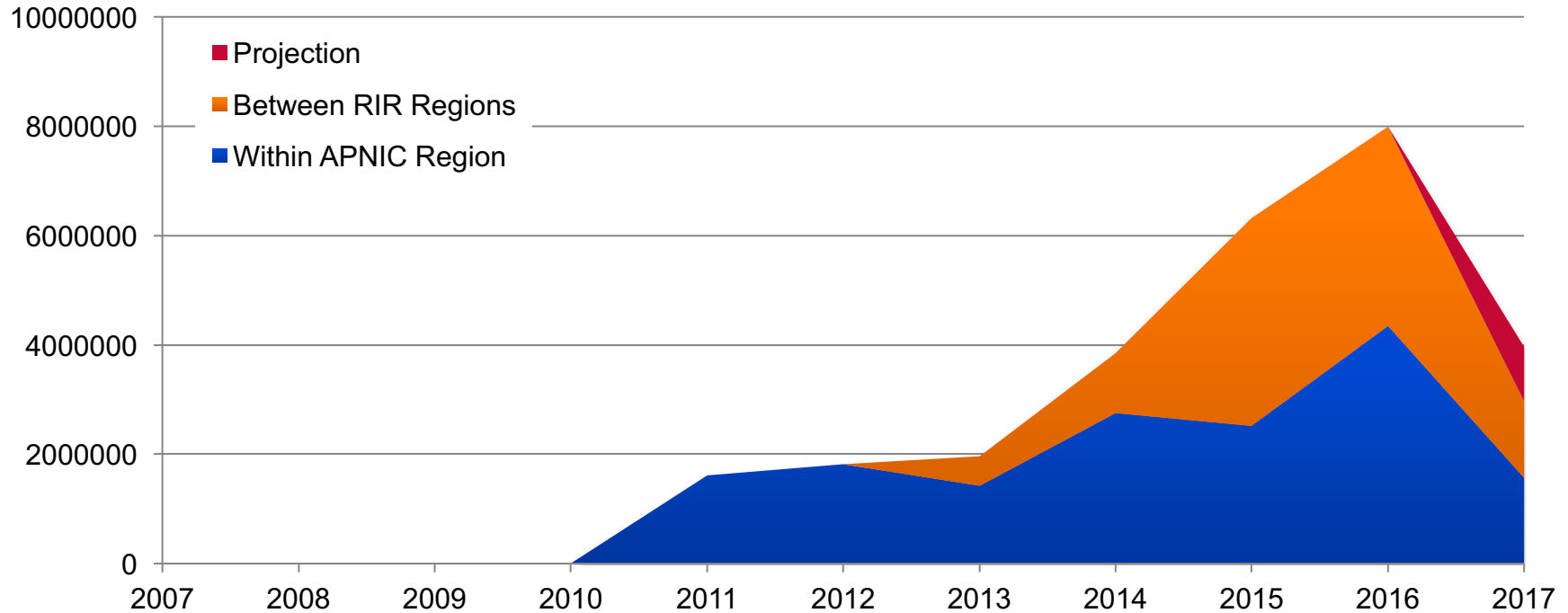
IPv4 Transfers



As at 30 Sep



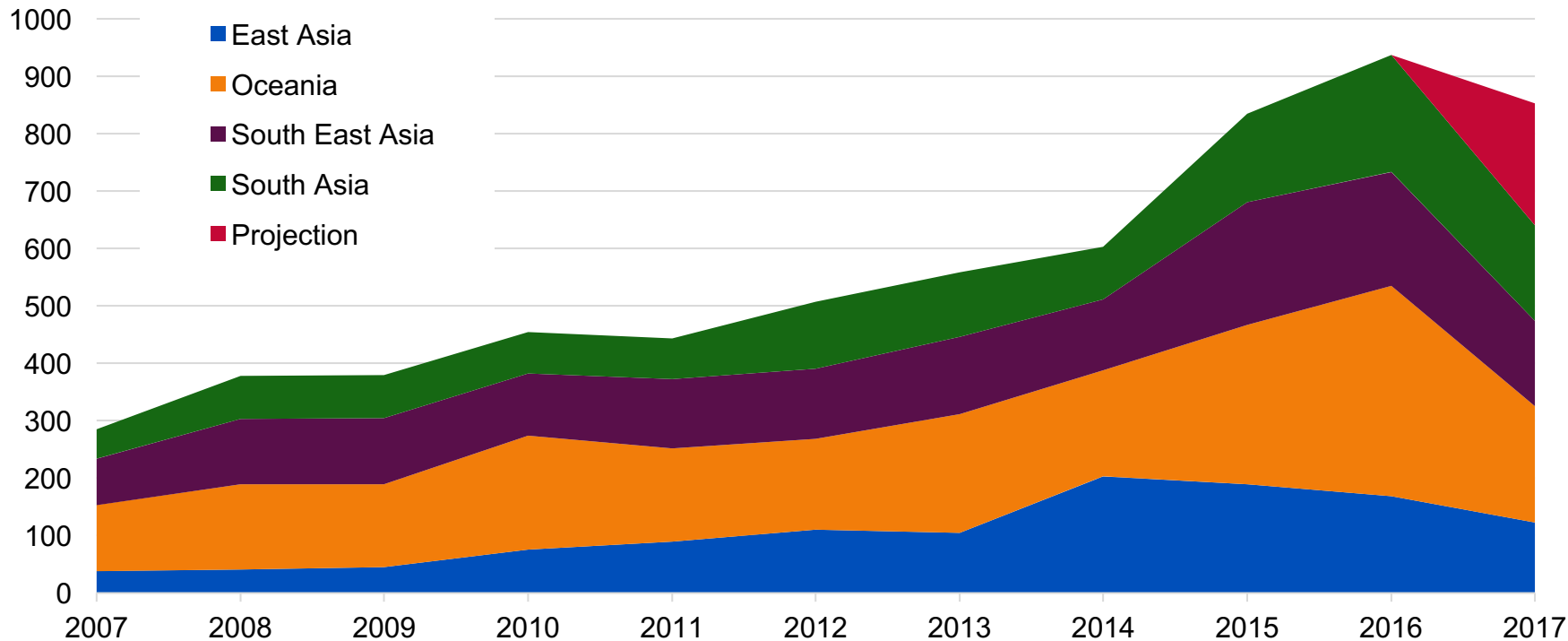
Total IPv4 Transferred

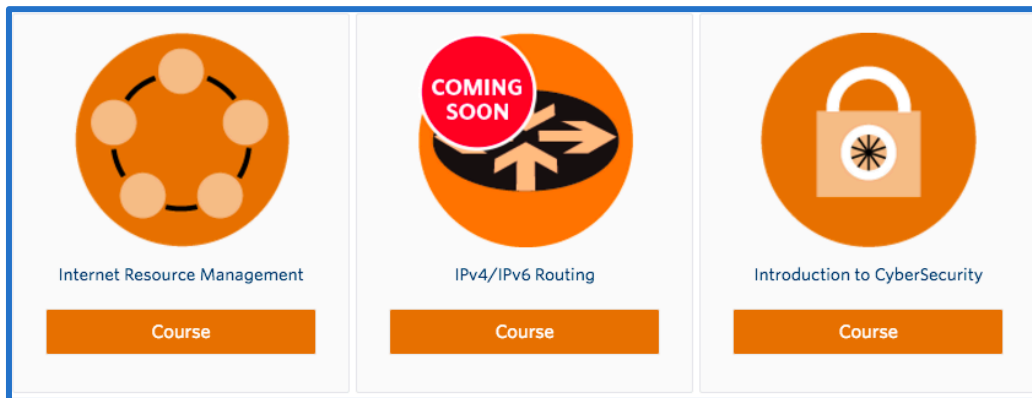

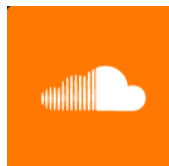
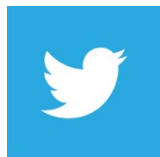
