- To develop positions of the RIPE community on IoT matters, operational and beyond

Proposed Charter



- To discuss challenges and opportunities of "IoT" for the RIPE community
- To serve as a focal point for the RIPE NCC regarding community input to their IoT activities, including liaisons [with other organisations]
- To invite IoT communities to for a dialogue on matters of operational relevance, including security, the numbering system, and applicability of standards
- To develop positions of the RIPE community on IoT matters[, operational and beyond]

Call for Volunteers



- Become the chair elect of the IoT Working Group
 - Pending RIPE community consensus on IoT WG
- Present at closing plenary Thursday
 - Introduce the proposed charter
 - Coordinate with RIPE chair to seek consensus on IoT WG

Chair Selection Procedure



- Consensus on using an existing procedure
- DNS WG was first suggested as the example to be used
 - Discussion around what to do when there is no direct consensus on candidates
 - Some opposition to DNS WG procedure to "Draw lots"
 - Other ideas on tie breakers? Use IPv6 WG text?
